

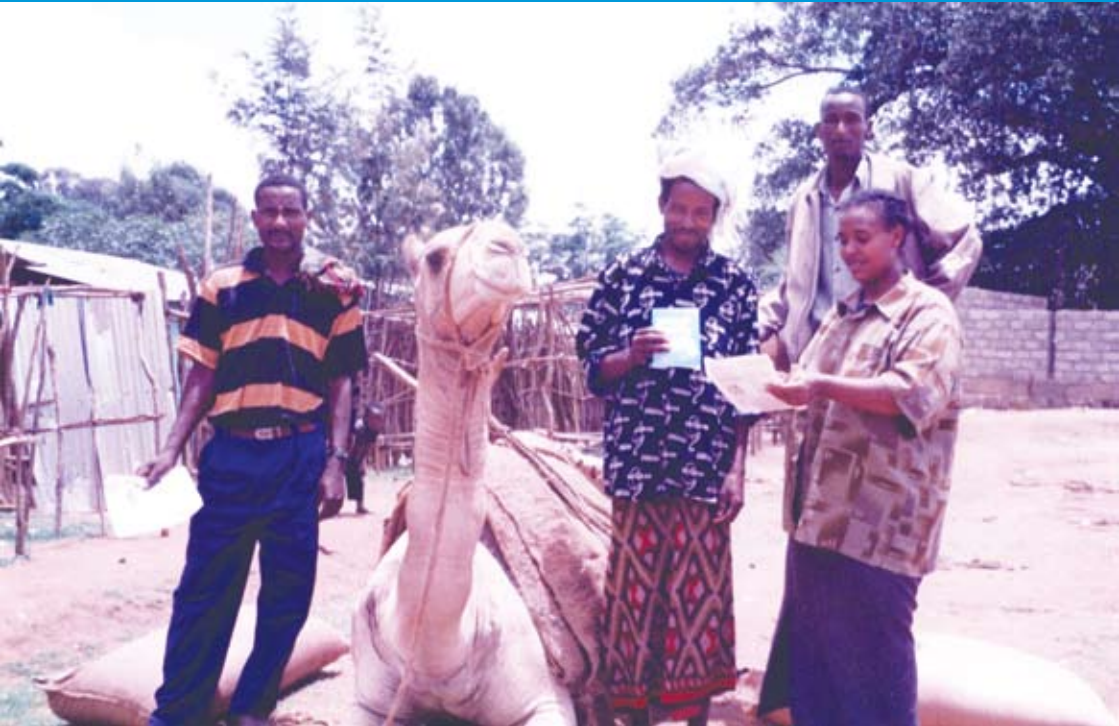

OUR TOTAL WORLD OUTREACH

WORLD LITERACY

Taking **all ages** into consideration, about 67% of the population of Africa can read today, 88% in Asia, and 86% of the world population (Unesco). But more than 1200 tribal languages are still without any part of the Bible (Wycliffe). And **that is the field** God has called us to work in - the more isolated languages of lesser-known communities, not yet successfully reached with the message of Christ !

PRACTICAL ACTION !

There are many impressive mission magazines published. But in spite of glamorous presentations, one must always ask - **what is really being done** in practice to bring the Gospel to the world's non-Christian communities ? By God's grace we have printed and distributed **6.4 million** copies free of charge in the past year, in **577** tribal languages (results on pages 3 to 6) !



One of the high-speed folding machines in Germany, cutting and folding the printed paper to produce the literature we send to 114 third-world countries. Together with the literature being sent out from South Africa, 6.4 million copies of Gospel literature were processed in this way last year.

RESULTS

JUST A FEW EXTRACTS FROM THEIR LETTERS !

According to the letters we receive **daily** from the 114 third-world countries where our Gospel literature is being distributed free of charge in non-Christian communities, we know that last year, **at least 14,423 people** in these non-Christian communities did accept Christ as their personal Saviour as a result of God's anointing on these Heart of Man books and other shorter Gospel messages. And as any research agency will confirm from their own experience of

such feedback, **that is only the tip of the iceberg !** There are without doubt many other people whose lives are also affected in a similar way through this Gospel literature, who simply do not think of actually writing a special letter to the publishers of that book or pamphlet in South Africa ! But the letters we **do receive** are most encouraging, and I'm sure they will also be a real inspiration and blessing to you, just as they are to us here at A.N.G.P. !

PAPUA NEW GUINEA NEW CHURCH STARTED !

BRAZIL DRUG DEALER SAVED, NOW RUNS REHABILITATION CENTRE

My reason for writing to you is to share our work in Brazil

with you. I am the director of a Rehabilitation Centre called "Vidas", which means "Lives". It is **because of your literature that I can help young people who are caught in the downward spiral of addiction.** When I was younger, I started drinking alcohol, then went on to marijuana, cocaine, crack and other stronger drugs, and I sank deeper and deeper into the world of drugs and despair. To support my habit, I became a drug dealer in one of the worst and most dangerous suburbs of Salvador, and because of my terrible lifestyle **I nearly died** from drug-related tuberculosis. It was while I was sick that one of the drug addicts that I used to sell drugs to, came to me and **gave me some of your literature.** This man was fully recovered from using drugs, and told me that Jesus had changed his life, and he encouraged me to read the tracts. When I read the tract, I saw how miserable my life was, and I wanted to be free like this man was. He prayed with me and took me to the rehabilitation centre. There I accepted Jesus as my Saviour, and today my life is **completely changed because of Jesus Christ!** Now I am using your literature here at the centre, and it has been a wonderful tool and a great blessing to

the young people who come here for help. **So many lives have been changed** through your literature, and I continually praise God for his love and mercy!

THE ANIMAL CARETAKERS

EXTREME MUSLIMS REACHED

This interesting script above is from our newly printed Heart of Man booklet in the **Saho language**. By God's grace, the heart's desire of Michael, our contact for this translation, has come true: "We now have a way to reach many people of different groups by having the Word of God **enter their homes** through the tracts and Heart Books ! Your literature is helping to spread the Gospel **into every home**, and it is possible that

every family member in that home will be exposed to the Gospel of Salvation, which is my sincere desire and burden". This **Muslim dominant group** of livestock farmers, known as "the animal caretakers", from the word "saa" which means animals and "hoo" which means caretaker, live in Eritrea and Ethiopia, near the coastal area of the Red Sea. They are **extreme Muslim believers under severe religious bondage**, which



makes their eyes blind and their ears deaf to the truth. “That’s why I (Michael) am burdened to reach these people with the message of Salvation. And as a first step towards reaching these people, I want to use the open door of All Nations Gospel Publishers to have the message of Salvation printed in their Saho language. **I have seen how miraculously indigenous people have been reached by the Holy Spirit through this literature,** and I want to make this message of Salvation available to many people, as the Lord leads me”.

The other reason for the great excitement about this recently printed language, is that these people only have a few Bible portions translated in their Saho language, and so this literature is really **arousing their interest, despite the religious bondage** they are living under. And one can see the interested expression on the face of the man in the photo on page 9, and the excitement on the faces of those who have already received their free copies of the Heart Book and “Where is Your Home?” tract in their own language !

MEET YOUR CO-WORKER

THE BOTTLE MAN !

With only 1440 minutes in a day, which cannot be saved or carried over for another day, time that has passed or been wasted is **gone forever !** The apostle Paul wrote, “Pay careful attention then, to how you live, not as unwise people, but as wise, **making the most of the time**, because the days are evil” (Eph. 5:15-16). We are urged to live our lives knowing God’s will for the ages, and the urgency of the **Great Commission**. And that is what each one of you are doing by faithfully making this Gospel literature available to people across the world. And we hope that you will be inspired by this report from one of your co-workers, as you

see some of the results of the seeds you are sowing ! “I am John (photo below) living in a coastal town in KwaZulu Natal, South Africa. In my strolling on the beach I came across your Gospel messages, “Who Will Deliver Me?” and “Two Roads”. They were found posted on top of a reed planted into the sea sand under a plastic bottle. These messages **spoke deep into my heart**, and I walked about two kilometres along the beach looking for more messages that I could take to share with others in my hometown. I continued to collect new Gospel messages for a few weeks and one day met “the Bottle Man” who has



been doing this for about a year. I then met his brother and the three of us prayed together on the beach where God spoke faith, hope and excitement into my heart. The Bottle Man gave me more tracts of the Good News of Jesus Christ that I now take to share with others alongside the roads and shopping malls in town. **I am now full of joy and great expectation** about what God has done for me and look forward to how He is going to be by my side in my future. **Thank you, All Nations Gospel Publishers, for providing these life changing messages** that can carry us through this life and into an eternity with God our Father and Jesus Christ our Saviour". The "**Bottle Man**" spoken of in John's testimony above is Norman Bosman (see photo page 12), who is the second generation of his family who have been mission friends of ANGP for over 70 years. His wife Lenie was employed full-time at ANGP in Pretoria for 27 years until they moved to the KwaZulu Natal coast where Norman could enjoy his favourite pastime - fishing! And when Norman received Salvation many years ago, he never realised that the Scripture in Matthew 4:19 "**Follow me, and I will make**

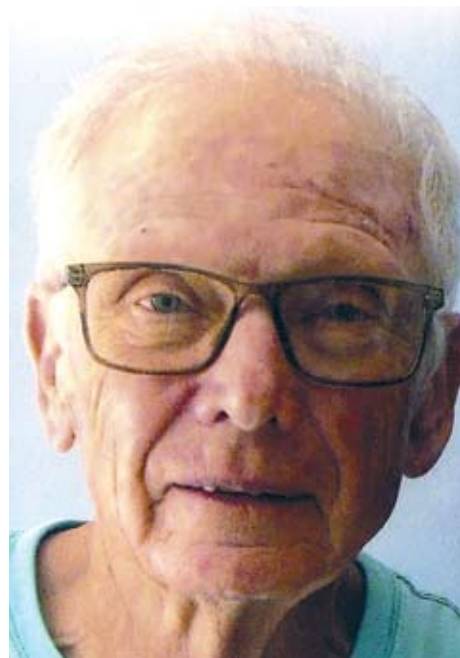


you fishers of men", would lead him to the bottle ministry. Here is Norman's account of how he became involved in this ministry. "Living at the beach front, I've seen many people spend hours on the beach. Initially I was drawn to the fishermen who sit waiting for a fish to bite. I started to write Scripture in the sand where the fishermen would walk. But I soon realized that with them carrying all their gear they did not stop to read anything and at a tide change the message was wiped out. There was debris on the beach, and amongst other items, reeds. After cleaning the reeds I was

left with perfect sticks. The reeds were cut to sizes and a split made on the top end. I planted the bottom end into the sand and inserted a Gospel pamphlet into the split end. We now have the literature at shoulder height which is more visible, and tracts were being taken. Some of the tracts became spoilt by the high humidity, overnight dew and rain. I found discarded water and coldrink bottles trashed on the beach. I cut off the bottom end and placed it over the literature on top of the reed (see photo page 11). This has now spread to about 20 posts over 5km's on a fishermen's beach. We see pedestrians who commute on the beach, idle meandering holiday makers and bush dwellers taking the literature. The empty reeds are replenished daily. Sometimes we find writing in the sand as affirmation to what has been found. On other occasions the reeds are broken, bottles removed but no tract. **Praise God the message is getting out!** A personal observation is that where the posts remain, crime seems to have reduced, as against the areas where the posts are destroyed and crime continues. People who have seen me stocking up the reeds are now calling me "the bottle-man". I praise

God for this Gospel Literature that is going out in a place not normally associated with evangelism!"

This story above just shows us again that if we are faithful in **doing our part** to make the literature available, God is faithful to raise up co-workers who **use the literature** in the most ingenious ways to spread the Gospel message! And we can depend on the Holy Spirit to multiply the seed, just as we see the Gospel messages left by the "Bottle Man" now being distributed even further by John at shopping centres to people who themselves do not walk along the beaches!



ANSWER TO PRAYER

Some of the things we may want, or pray for, may seem to be so obviously right for us. And yet, God doesn't always see things the same way we do (Isaiah 55:8,9). And sometimes God doesn't remove the obstacle from our lives, but instead gives us the strength to cope with life in spite of our problems (2 Cor. 12:9,10).

But what is of course always encouraging, is the fact that it **is possible** in many cases for God to give us the answer to prayer that we would like to have, in full consideration of His foresight, His wisdom, and His plan for our lives. Like the letter we received from a young man in Benin, who asked us to pray for him **six years ago**, and has not forgotten to let us know how this request was answered! His prayer request was for his parents who were planning to separate, which would have left him and his siblings "abandoned and suffering" (his own words). He expressed **such fear for the uncertainty of his future** if his family did not stay together, and in his desperation he reached out to a mission press in another

part of the world, to strangers he knew only from a Gospel tract! But we have seen the faithfulness and goodness of God in so many ways here at A.N.G.P. And when we heard how God had undertaken for this young man, we were encouraged by the fact that no matter where we are in the world, and irrespective of the fact that we do not know each other personally, **we can stand together in prayer!** By God's grace he has now become actively involved in helping at Sunday School. And at the university where he is studying medicine, he participates in Christian activities, Bible studies, prayer meetings and evangelism **to reach other students for Jesus.** What an encouragement such a testimony is to our faith!

Then there are also answers to prayer that people simply take for granted, such as the fact that you and we **are actually working together successfully** to bring the Gospel message to non-Christian communities, and the fact that people's lives **are being changed** as a result of our combined efforts and prayers (pages 3 to 6)!

ALL NATIONS GOSPEL PUBLISHERS

ORIGIN

A Swiss soldier by the name of J.R. Gschwend fell into the hands of German forces in the 1st World War, was accused of espionage, and sentenced to death. In his death-cell he experienced an extraordinary spiritual awakening, and found God in a remarkable way. When the German forces released him without explanation, he dedicated his life to the service of God, qualified as a minister of religion, and left by ship for Africa in 1921 where he eventually established this Gospel Literature Mission in 1935. His son Manasseh and eventually his grandson Eugene, both qualified ministers of religion, continued the work, resulting in today's world-wide Gospel Literature Mission of 89 years standing, growth and experience.

OBJECTIVE

Since its establishment in 1935, the objective has been to **translate** the Gospel message into the unreached languages of the world's more isolated communities, to **print** these Gospel booklets, and to **distribute** them free of charge in these more isolated and even unreached communities. Today, approximately 1 700 tribal **languages** are still without any part of the Bible in print, and over 6 474 more isolated **tribes** have still not been effectively penetrated by the Gospel message, involving no less than **1 630 million people** who are still registered today as completely **unreached** with the Gospel !

ANNUAL OUTREACH

New translations of the Gospel message: We complete and print from 6 to 8 new translations every year for isolated tribes and unreached languages.

Printing: We print just on 6.7 million copies of the Gospel message each year at our own Mission Press, and in Germany, as well as in some other countries.

Distributing of Gospel literature free of charge: We sort, pack and distribute an average of 312 parcels of free Gospel literature every month world-wide.

Languages and Countries reached: At present we print and distribute in altogether 577 tribal languages, with free distribution in 114 third-world countries.

MESSAGE

Our free Gospel literature is of a very **basic nature**, designed to present the **simple Gospel message** to those who know nothing about the Christian faith in the world's more isolated and even unreached communities. We therefore avoid as far as possible any contentious **doctrinal issues** related to specific church organizations, and **specially design** the message to relate in a practical way to the particular culture, customs and idiom of each specific tribal community.

RESULTS

The **testimonies** we receive in the letters reaching us daily from 114 third-world countries, prove that many people in those more isolated non-Christian communities, are being **led to Christ** through this free Gospel literature by God's grace (see pages 3 to 6) ! And in the process, we are also with God's help reaching **new languages** with the message of salvation in Christ !

FINANCING

Since 1935, this mission has operated **in faith**, trusting God to supply financially in the form of donations made to this work by children of the Lord who feel led to make their own **personal contribution** towards bringing the Gospel to the world's more isolated and even unreached communities. This mission therefore relies solely on the donations **being received** to finance its operation. **The miracle** is that although it is not our policy to ask for finances or to make our needs known to the public even for special projects, somehow, every month, God lays this matter on people's hearts, and **God honours the faith of His children !**

CONTROL

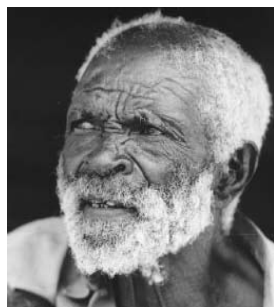
The A.N.G.P. Mission in South Africa is accountable to its head-office in Switzerland, from where this work was established in 1935, and registered in South Africa as an "Association not for gain". In accordance with South African law, the Mission's books are audited annually by a firm of registered auditors, reports are lodged locally and at our head-office in Switzerland, and the Mission is operated in South Africa under the control of a member of the Swiss A.N.G.P. Mission Board – Rev. Eugene Gschwend, a qualified and ordained minister of religion of 48 years standing.
